

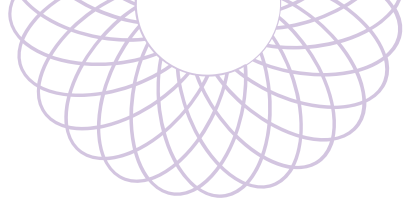

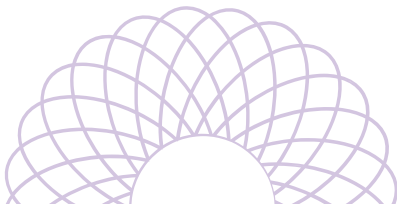
O U R V I S I O N

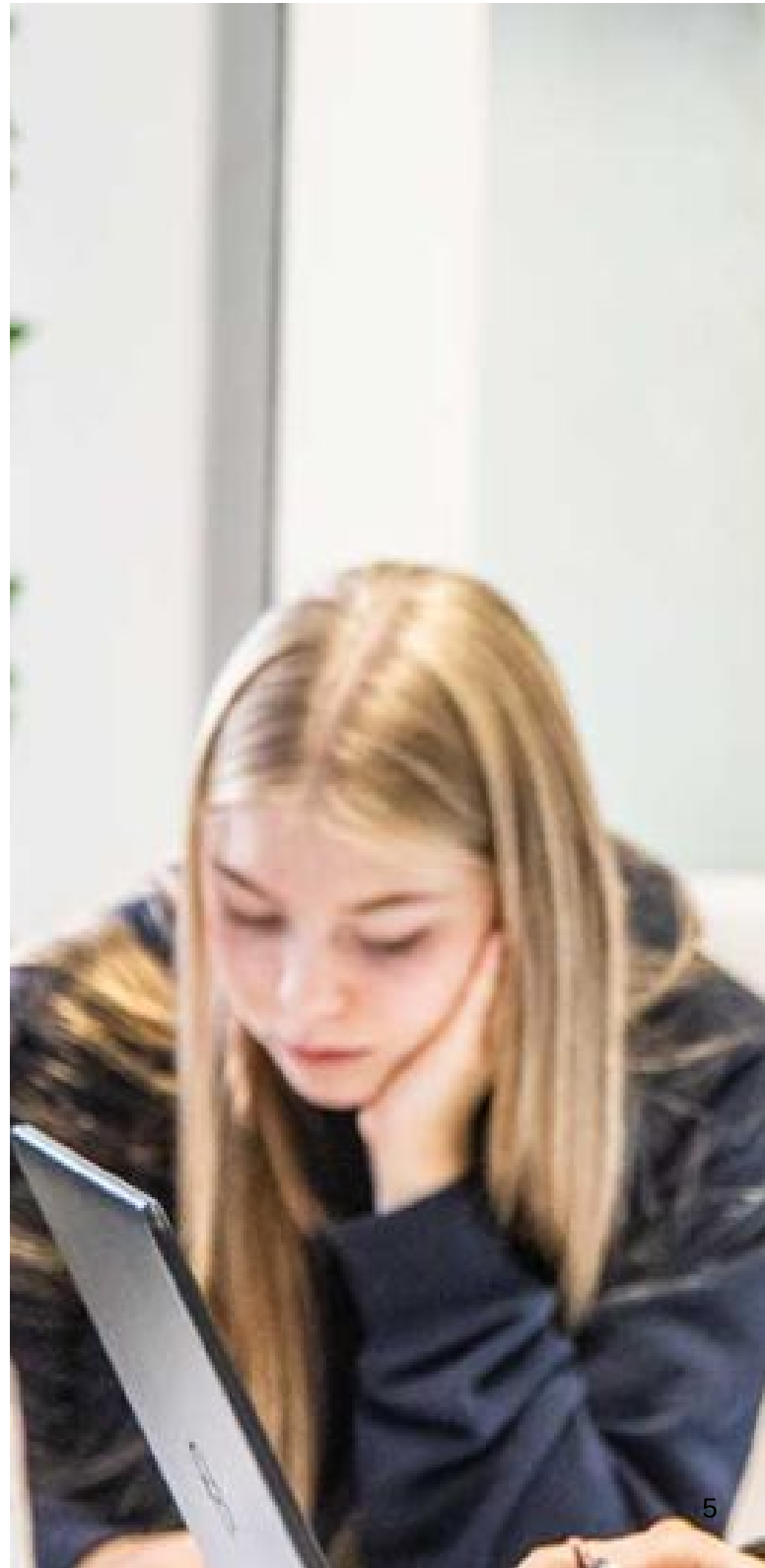


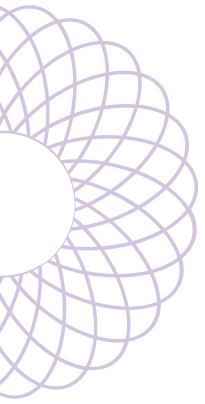
HURST CURRICULUM PATHWAY

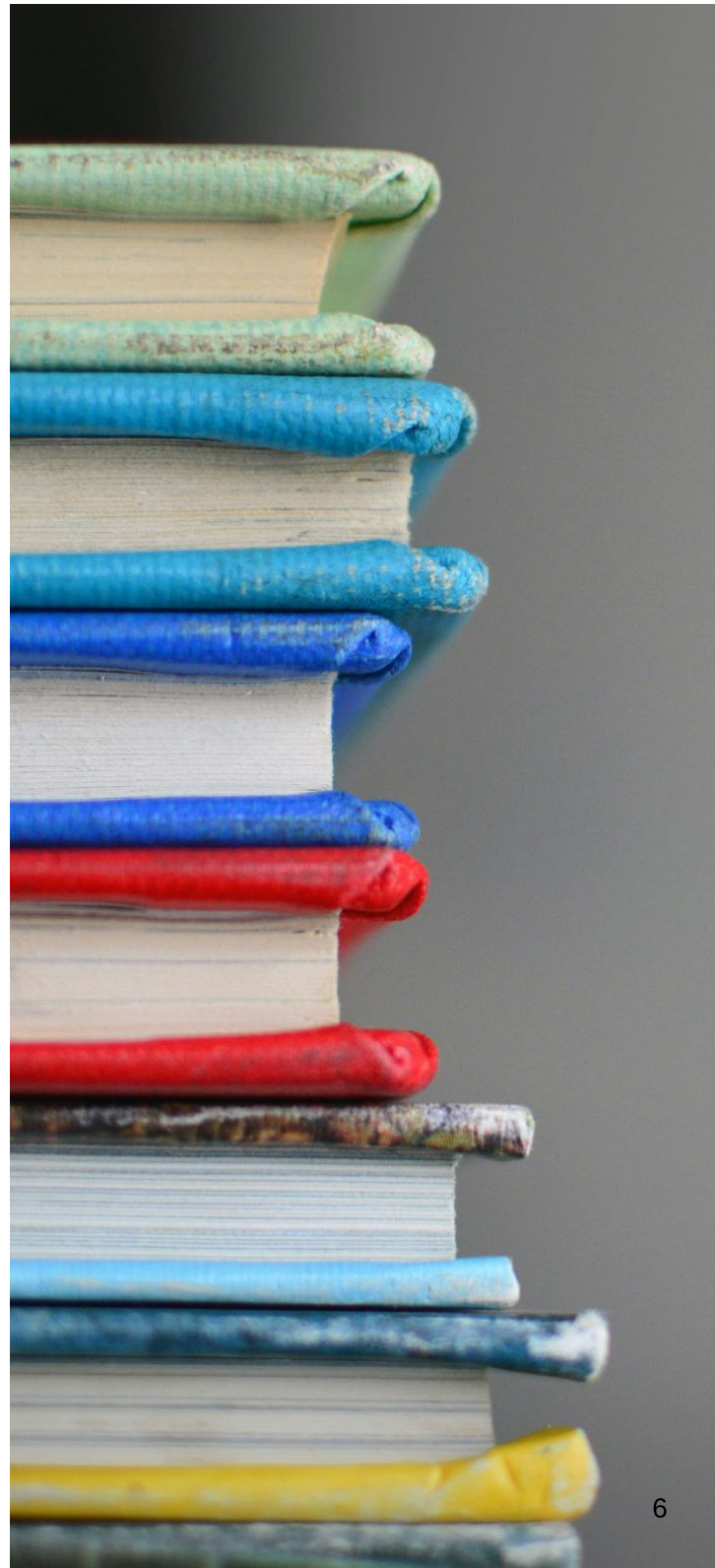

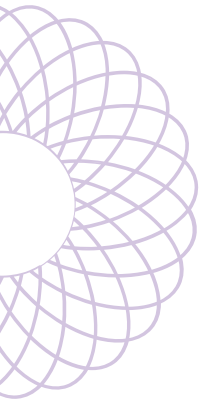

T H R I V E C U R R I C U L U M P A T H W A Y

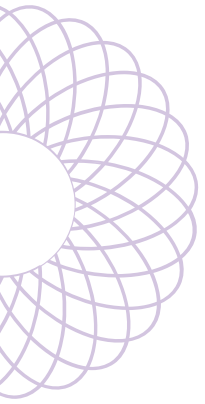
Our Thrive Pathway focuses on personal growth, confidence, and readiness for the future.
